Arriving from Milan:

By plane:

For those arriving in Milan (MALPENSA - MXP), there are usually two daily flights to Pescara Airport. One departs in the morning between 7:00 and 8:30 a.m., and the other departs in the evening between 9:00 and 11:00 p.m. So, it depends greatly on your arrival time from Boston. The journey time is approximately 1 hour to 1 hour and 20 minutes.

By train:

From Milan Malpensa Airport, a high-speed train departs every 30 minutes, taking passengers directly to Milan Central Station. From there, you can take a train to Pescara. The journey from Milan to Pescara takes approximately 5 hours.
